

Privacy Policy

Del Monte International GmbH, along with our parents, subsidiaries and affiliates (“DMI”, “We” or “Us”), are deeply committed to safeguarding your privacy. It is important for you to understand what information we collect about you during your visit to our web site and what we do with that information. As such, we ask that you please read this privacy policy before using our web site, as your use of our web site constitutes your acceptance of these terms.

Your visit to and use of our web site is subject to this Privacy Policy and our Terms of Use. Please note that this Privacy Policy governs only information provided to (or generated through your visit to) our web site and communications originating from our web site.

Personal Information

We do not automatically collect personal information – such as names, addresses, telephone numbers, and e-mail addresses – from our web site users. However, users of our web site may choose to volunteer this type of information when they register as members, make purchases, participate in promotions, and submit online job applications. When you submit your personal information to us, you are giving your consent to the collection, use and disclosure of your personal information as set forth in this Privacy Policy. While we may use this personal information as a basis for enhancing our web site, we never rent, sell or transfer it to third parties.

Compliance with laws and other disclosures

We may disclose any information, including personal information in order to comply with any applicable law, regulation, legal process, or governmental, regulatory or law enforcement request.

In the event that we sell or buy any business or assets we may disclose your personal information to the prospective seller or buyer of such business or assets. Equally, if a third party acquires us, or substantially all of our assets, personal information will be one of the assets transferred to the acquirer.

If you elect to participate in any promotions, sweepstakes, surveys, questionnaires, or other events during your visit to our web site, the rules or terms and conditions for those events may indicate additional terms on which your personal information will be used or shared with third parties. Other Information

Our servers automatically collect certain non-personally identifiable information, such as the type of operating system or web browser used by each of our users. Our website also uses cookies. A cookie is a small file that we put on your computer. Cookie data allows us to distinguish you from other users of the website. We use this data to provide an enhanced online experience to track the aggregate number of users to our site and for marketing communication. By using our web site, you consent to this use. In line with the rest of our privacy policy, we do not sell or transfer any non-personally identifiable user information or cookie data to third parties. Rather, we retain it and may use it as a basis for making improvements to our web site. Such uses include reminding us who you are so we can access your account information and give you a better, more personalized service. The cookie that enables this is set when you register or "Sign In" and is modified when you "Sign Out" of certain parts of our service.

Other examples of how we use cookies are as follows:

Estimate our audience size.

Each browser accessing our site is given a unique cookie, which is then used to track repeat usage and calculate the amount of usage by registered vs. unregistered users. We use this data to help us target our advertisements to users who are most likely to be interested in them.

Track your progress and number of entries in some of our promotions, sweepstakes, and contests.

When a DMI promotion uses cookies, the information written to the cookie indicates the participant's progress through the promotion, and may be used to track entries, submissions, and status in prize draws.

Measure certain traffic and visiting patterns in the aggregate.

We use this research to understand how our users' habits are similar or different from one another so that we can make each new experience on our web site a better one. We may use this information to personalize content, banners, and promotions that you and other users will see on our site.

You can have your browser notify you of, or automatically reject, cookies. If you reject our cookies, you may still use our web site, but some of the features may not work. For further information regarding cookies, including details of how to refuse them, please visit www.allaboutcookies.org.

Security

We consider your privacy and the security of your transactions while in a secure portion of our site to be of the utmost importance. To protect the interests of children who visit our site, it is our policy not to solicit or post any personal information from users under 12 years old without the consent of a parent or legal guardian. In the event that a child younger than 12 submits information to our web site without this consent and we become aware of it, we will delete the information. We do not actively seek demographic or preference information from children, we will not send direct e-mail offers to users who indicate they are younger than 12, and we do not knowingly or intentionally disclose personal information regarding children to third parties.
